The M-BRACE Scope Mounting System embodies an evolutionary step taken from ARC's successful M10 Scope Rings that have served thousands of riflemen for over a decade. It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

Introduction

- Be aware that when attached to the far aft recoil slot on an action with 90degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height MBRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. Move the mount forward 1 slot to avoid this issue.
- Always check the stability of the mount and scope before firing to ensure they are securely fastened.
- Use the appropriate torque specifications during installation:
 - Scope clamp and rail mount screws: 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs)
 - Bubble level screw: 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs)

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Start by ensuring that the firearm is unloaded and safe to handle.
- Clean the picatinny rail where the mount will be attached to ensure a secure fit.
- Position the MBRACE Scope Mount on the desired slot of the picatinny rail.
- Using a torque wrench, tighten the scope clamp and rail mount screws to the specified torque of 6.2 Nm (55 inlbs).
- If applicable, attach the bubble level screw and tighten to a torque of 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs).
- Doublecheck all screws to ensure they are securely fastened.

2. Usage:

- After installation, check the alignment of the scope and make necessary adjustments.
- Always wear appropriate eye protection when using firearms.
- Regularly inspect the mount and scope during use to ensure they remain secure and properly aligned.
- If any issues arise, cease use immediately and consult a professional.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the MBRACE Scope Mounts in accordance with local regulations for electronic and metal waste.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
