It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

 - 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs) for the bubble level screw.
- Use the scope mount only with compatible scope tube diameters (34mm) to ensure proper fit and functionality.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Begin by selecting the appropriate position on the picatinny rail for mounting.
- Align the MBRACE Scope Mount with the selected slot on the rail.
- Secure the mount using the provided screws, ensuring that they are tightened to the specified torque settings.
