It is an engineered product standing alone in stark contrast to the conveniently designed gadgets for which engineering was never a consideration. NOTE: When attached to the far aft recoil slot in the picatinny rail on an action with 90 degree bolt rotation, the 32mm height M-BRACE serrated interface block may interfere with the bolt handle when opened. This issue can usually be avoided by moving the mount forward 1 slot in the picatinny rail. Torque spec: 6.2 Nm (55 in-lbs) on scope clamp and rail mount screws. Torque spec: 3.4 Nm (30 in-lbs) on bubble level screw.

  - Use 3.4 Nm (30 inlbs) on the bubble level screw.
- **Installation Location:** Ensure proper placement on the picatinny rail to avoid interference with the rifle's operation.
