# Safety Instruction Guide for the CZ USA 75 B 9MM LUGER SEMIAUTO HANDGUN

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CZ USA 75 B 9MM LUGER SEMIAUTO HANDGUN. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe handling and use of your handgun. It is important to read and understand these instructions thoroughly before using the product.
