The PCR name stands for Police Czech Republic, the group for whom the model was originally designed. Nearly identical in size to the CZ 75 Compact, it weighs in at a full 1/4 pound lighter owing to its forged aluminum frame, making it more comfortable for everyday carry. Very similar to the P-01, the PCR uses the same alloy frame minus the light rail, making it even more concealable

# Safety Instruction Guide for CZ 75D PCR

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CZ 75D PCR. This guide provides important safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use of your firearm. Please read this document carefully before using the product.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- Keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction at all times.

- Do not rely on the safety mechanism alone; always follow safe handling practices.
- If the firearm fails to fire after pulling the trigger, keep it pointed downrange for at least 30 seconds before safely unloading.
- Be mindful of the firearm's weight (1.7 lbs) and size (7.2 inches in length) when carrying it for extended periods.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### • Loading the Firearm:

1. Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
2. Check the chamber to confirm it is empty.
3. Insert the magazine into the magazine well until it clicks into place.
4. Pull the slide back to chamber a round.

### • Unloading the Firearm:

1. Point the firearm in a safe direction.
2. Remove the magazine by pressing the magazine release button.
3. Pull the slide back to eject any round in the chamber.
4. Visually and physically check the chamber to ensure it is empty.

- **Cleaning and Maintenance:** Regularly clean your firearm according to the manufacturer's instructions. Use only approved cleaning supplies for firearms. Store your firearm in a dry and secure location.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any used ammunition and firearm components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of firearms in regular waste. Consult local authorities for proper disposal methods.
