CHAMBER SAFETY FLAGS USER MANUAL

Introduction

- Open the action of the firearm again to ensure it is pointed in a safe direction.
- Carefully pull the chamber safety flag out of the chamber.

- Dispose of damaged or worn chamber safety flags in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the chamber safety flag in regular household waste if it is damaged. Instead, take it to a designated disposal facility for hazardous materials.
