Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the SIG CROSS® PMAGS 7.62 AC MAGPUL PMAG 5. This safety instruction guide is designed to provide you with essential information about the safe use, installation, and disposal of your magazine, in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR). - If modifying for 6 rounds, follow the manufacturer's instructions carefully.

- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- To unload, press the follower down and remove the cartridges one at a time.

4. Maintenance:

- Clean the magazine periodically using a soft cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals that may damage the polymer material.
- Check for any cracks or wear and replace the magazine if necessary.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine responsibly, in accordance with local regulations.
