With the significantly increased chamber support, the V2 contour barrels are better suited for modern configurations where lights, lasers and suppressors all add to a commonly muzzle heavy carbine. The transfer of material to the rear of the barrel helps to offset the weight of accessories, and stiffens the barrel at the same time - reducing POI shifts between suppressed and unsuppressed use. The gas journal length has been shortened as well to optimized weight distribution, so please note that fixed front sight bases will not fit on this barrel, only low-profile gas blocks. V2 barrels remain appropriately gassed for use with or without a suppressor of your choosing. The Cold Hammer Forged version is a great option for shooters who frequently get their carbines hot, and are looking for a highly durable barrel.
