Just squeeze the sides of the tube to release CR-123s in the middle or bottom of the CellVault. Clean it with a test tube or bottle brush. The CellVault is made with food-safe thermoformed plastic. This model of CellVault is not designed to be waterproof under prolonged submersion. Subsequently, it is not designed for diving. Users should check the lip and O-ring of the CellVault for debris or wear that could prevent it from being waterproof over time.
