 - A 3 3/8" (9.2cm) x 5/32" (4mm) diameter.
 - B 3 5/8" (9.2cm) long x 3/32" (2.4cm) diameter.
 - D 4 1/2" (11.4cm) long x 5/32" (4mm) diameter.
 - F 4 3/4" (10.8cm) long x 1/8" (3.2mm) diameter.
 - Drift punch - brass, 3 3/4" (8.3cm) long x 3/16" (4.8mm) diameter.
- Firmly grip the knurled handle of the punch to prevent slippage.
- Position the punch on the pin or component you wish to disassemble or reassemble.
- Gently tap the punch with a hammer to drive the pin out or into place.

3. **PostUse**

- Clean the punches after use to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the punches in their designated case to prevent damage and keep them organized.

Disposal Instructions

When disposing of the Pistol Punch Set, please follow these guidelines:

- Do not dispose of the punches in regular household waste.
- Check local regulations regarding the disposal of metal tools and materials.
