Introduction

Thank you for choosing the TRIPLE SHOCK X 7MM (0.284") Boat Tail Bullets by Barnes Bullets. This guide provides important safety instructions to ensure the safe use of this product. Please read this document carefully to understand how to handle, use, and dispose of the bullets properly.
