Safety Instruction Guide for MARK IV™ 22/45™ MAGAZINES

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MARK IV™ 22/45™ MAGAZINES. This guide provides important safety instructions and information to ensure the safe use of your replacement magazine for the Ruger® Mark IV™ 22/45™ pistol. Please read this guide carefully before use.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the magazine is compatible with your Ruger® Mark IV™ 22/45™ pistol model.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Insert the magazine into the magazine well of the Ruger® Mark IV™ 22/45™ until it clicks into place.
- Confirm that the magazine is securely attached by gently pulling on it.

2. Loading the Magazine:

- Place the magazine on a flat surface.
- Press the side button to lower the polymer follower.
- Insert .22 LR cartridges into the magazine, ensuring they are oriented correctly.
- Release the side button to allow the follower to rise, securing the cartridges in place.
- Repeat until the magazine is loaded to the desired capacity, but do not exceed 10 rounds.

3. Using the Magazine:

- Insert the loaded magazine into the firearm as instructed above.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for operating your Ruger® Mark IV™ 22/45™ pistol.
- Always ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction when loading or unloading.

4. Unloading the Magazine:

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Press the side button to lower the follower and allow the cartridges to be removed safely.
- Inspect the magazine and cartridges for any signs of damage or malfunction.
