# Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 Premium Barrels .223 Wylde

## Introduction

- Use only the specified gas block seat for .750" low profile gas blocks.
- Ensure that the twist rate of 1:8 inches is suitable for the ammunition you intend to use.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Installation:

- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded before beginning installation.
- Remove the existing barrel from the upper receiver if applicable.
- Align the new barrel with the upper receiver, ensuring proper fit.
- Securely fasten the barrel to the upper receiver according to the manufacturer's specifications.
- Install the gas block at the specified gas block journal of 1.03".
- Ensure that the muzzle is threaded 1/2x28 and properly affix any muzzle device.

### 2. Usage:

- Always verify that the firearm is unloaded before handling.
- Load ammunition that is compatible with the .223 Wylde chamber.
- Conduct a function test to ensure the firearm operates correctly after installation.
- Maintain situational awareness and adhere to all safety protocols while firing.

- Dispose of the barrel in accordance with local laws and regulations concerning firearm components.
- If the barrel is damaged or no longer in use, consider contacting a licensed firearms dealer for proper

disposal methods.
